Beyond Beck Road is a public art event where the street becomes an exhibition space for the extended community, reflecting its location in the heart of Hackney as a vibrant and culturally expansive borough, this project will reach beyond a traditional gallery audience, positively impacting the broader community. The event focuses on the present community and its extended artistic and creative connections, working in conjunction with Open House London to highlight the road's significant heritage. Beck Road itself houses resident artists, artist studios and workshops. It is a living breathing creative space which is using the Street as a communal stage of common ground through inclusivity, participation and collaboration.
